READING & DISTRICT FREE CHURCH COUNCIL

[The Council was formed in 1896 as the Reading & District Evangelical Free Church Federation. It was renamed as a Council in 1916.

It consisted of the ministers of all affiliated churches <u>ex officio</u>; elected representatives of each church; and up to 20 co-opted members. Meetings were held quarterly.

The purposes of the Council were the promotion of evangelical unity, evangelism, and moral and social welfare, specifically excluding party political matters.

In 1975 it became a subsidiary of the local Council of Churches (later Churches Together in Reading). The Council ceased in 1993 when it formally amalgamated with Churches Together in Reading.]
