#### Introduction

William Thornton was born in 1814, the son of a stonemason and in 1840 established his own business. When his sons, Richard and James, joined the firm it was named William Thornton & Sons, Stonemasons. William died in 1878 and the firm continued to expand as a general contacting organisation. The partnership was converted into a limited company in 1916. The firm was based at 38 Wellington Road, Dingle. In 1936 (or 1932 according to the collection donor) a new masonry works was opened at the corner of Wellington Road and Grafton Street, by the Herculaneum Dock. The stonemasonry business ceased in 1961 and the firm closed in 1969.

The collection contains photographs of the yard, workforce and commissions of William Thornton & Sons, Stonemasons. Two of the photograph albums included in the collection contain photographs taken by Stewart Bale. National Museums Liverpool holds the archives of Stewart Bale Ltd.

The collection is held at the North Street Store of the Maritime Archives & Library and is only accessible by prior appointment. It was donated to National Museums Liverpool by Arthur Worrall. Mr. Worrall started work for William Thornton as an apprentice on 14 April 1932, he was later a stonemason and foreman.
