Seccombes Ltd department store was established c1894 by George A Seccombe and appears in a directory 1895 as George A Seccombe & Co, fancy drapers, milliners and costumiers, at 45 Queen Street, Cardiff, but moved c1896 to Bon Marche 22 Queen Street (closed after 1924). By 1920 Seccombes Ltd had also acquired premises at 79, 81, 83 Queen Street. Brief descriptions and illustrations are given in *Images of Cardiff* (South Wales Echo 1995) and *The City and Port of Cardiff. The Official Handbook* (various dates c1955-1964).
