Administrative/biographical history

Cecilia Williams lived in Aberdare and trained as a teacher after the Second World War. The majority of the photographs are of pupils and staff taken at schools where she worked. She also taught at schools in Birmingham and Radnorshire.

The series of earlier photographs came from her father, Ebenezer Williams, who was involved in shows and singing groups in the Aberdare area.

Scope and content
