Administrative/Biographical history

Cefn Malby Hospital was situated in the St Mellons region of Cardiff. A former Tudor Manor House, Cefn Malby House became a tuberculosis sanatorium in the 1920s. In 1924 it held 112 patients. Subsequently it became a general hospital. When it closed down in 1983 the building quickly became derelict and fire damaged. In 1994 the remains of the building were converted and luxury apartments were built on the site.
