## Name of creator(s):

Howard Gardens Higher Grade School, later Howard Gardens High School for Boys, Lady Margaret High School for Girls and Howardian High School.

#### Administrative/biographical history

The school was established at Howard Gardens in January 1885 as a result of the Aberdare Report on Intermediate and Higher Education in Wales 1880. The report was considered by Cardiff School Board in November 1882. The school was opened with the intention of providing a longer period of education for children up to the age 13 and a wider curriculum but its position was anomalous since it had been by an authority which possessed clear educational jurisdiction only over elementary schools, not intermediate or technical education under the Welsh Intermediate Education Act and the Technical Instruction Act 1889. A close reading of the law in these matters meant that Cardiff School Board was providing an educational service for which it had no legal powers. The school, as a consequence, was known as the Cardiff Higher Grade School till 1909 since it was regarded as a 'higher elementary' school despite the fact that it provided a secondary education on a par with intermediate and technical schools. The school was divided into a lower or elementary department and an upper or secondary department. The clear need for secondary education in Cardiff meant a rapid expansion in roll numbers. By 1892 it was providing secondary education for 865 boys and girls. Under the Education Act 1902, elementary and secondary education was transferred to Cardiff County Borough and the two departments were amalgamated. It was renamed the Municipal Secondary School, Cardiff, in 1906 but in 1909 the girls were formed into a separate municipal secondary school. The schools were re-named Howard Gardens High School for Boys and Lady Margaret High School for Girls in 1933.

The boys' school moved in 1953 to new premises in Colchester Avenue, Penylan, Cardiff, taking the name of the Howardian High School for Boys. Lady Margaret High School was amalgamated with the boys' school in ?1968 to form Howardian High School.

The premises in Howard Gardens were requisitioned between 1914 and 1920 by the military with the boys and girls being moved respectively to Crwys Road School and Allensbank Infants School premises. During the Second World War, the Howard Gardens buildings were badly damaged by bombing and some early records for the girls school were lost.

#### **Archival history**

Some of the early records were destroyed during the Second World War by German bombing. Most of the records passed on closure of the school in 1990 to T.J. Foster, teacher in the boys' school and joint school 1934 and 1945-1976, and to lan Myhres, chairman of the Save Howardian Action Campaign. Foster used the records as research for his history of the school. These were amalgamated with those collected by Myhre when these were added in September 2005.
