CONTEXT

Administrative/Biographical history: St. Dyffrig is a modern parish, formed in 1895 from the ancient parish of St. Mary in Cardiff. Records also include St. Barnabas church, Cardiff. The church, dedicated to St. Dyffrig and located in Wood Street, Cardiff, was erected between 1889 and 1907 as a chapel of ease to St. Mary's church and parish, Cardiff. On 1 October 1967 St.Dyfrig was united with the parish of Upper Grangetown to form the parish of Cardiff St.Dyfrig and St.Samson. The parish church of St.Dyfrig having been closed to enable Wood Street to be widened and the bridge rebuilt. Registers after 1967 are listed under Cardiff St.Samson P155CW.
