Minute Book 1703 - 1736, 1742, 1745 - 1824,

Containing appointments of mayors, aletasters and mayors accounts. The section from 1703 - 1736, 1742, appears to have been a separate volume at one time but was subsequently bound with the latter part of the minute book. The account of 1745 itemise 3/paid for a new book for the use of the mayor. 1745 - 1824.

- 1745 the aletaster, usually appointed by the mayor, is appointed by the burgesses.
- 1746 the aletaster acknowledges to have received one brass quart one brass pint and one brass bell being standards belonging to the borough.
- 1754 the appointment of aletaster reverts to the mayor and in subsequent years alternates between these two bodies.

The Mayors accounts cease with the accounts of 1754 and continue in 1760 - 3, 1766, 1768, 1780, 1796, 1997, 1803, 1808 -1811, 1817, 1821. The book is concerned very largely with the upkeep of the market and in 1796 there is an attempt to resuscitate the fair by farmers etc. with a subscription for expenses. 1795 .- Town clerk appointed - Theo. Gilbert. 1804. "Common seal of the Borough" (impression not discernible) 1807. John Gilbert appointed town clerk vice Theo. Gilbert. 1810. Purchase of standard weights. 1817. Extensive repairs to market house.

Minute Book 1825 - 8, 1830 - 1835, 1847 - 1852, 1854, 1857. Containing list of mayors 1742 - 1860.

Accounts of John Fowell, recorder 1825 - 27.

1828 - Duke of Beaufort offers to rebuild the market house provided the borough surrenders fair tolls to the duke.

1832 - Signature of Town Clerk and Mayor of Overmonnow.

1835 - Water supply to Grosmont.

1847 - Signatures of Bandmaster.

1850 - Mayor, Aletaster, Recorder and Town Clerk (4 persons)
