#### JOHN THOMPSON PHOTOGRAPH COLLECTION.

(Second sequence)

John Thompson senior (d. c1853) founded a small company of stone & marble masons in Peterborough in the late 1810's/early 1820's. The firm grew, and in 1828 was responsible, working together with Francis Ruddle's joiners & carpenters (who were subsequently taken over), for restoration work to Peterborough Cathedral. The success at Peterborough led to a strong interest in ecclesiastical restoration work, and they did this for at least one-third of the Cathedrals in the U.K., (including, Chester, Hereford, Lincoln, Ripon, Salisbury, & Winchester), they also repaired (and sometimes built) numerous parish churches; they made church furniture for even more. Thompsons involved themselves with institutional building, being responsible for Glasgow University; Royal Holloway College, Egham; Selwyn College, Cambridge, and many buildings in Peterborough. Furthermore, they built, altered or repaired large country houses: Irnham Hall, Lincs; Flixton Hall, Suffolk; Hever Castle, Kent; Sandringham House, Norfolk; and Durham Castle.

John Thompson junior died in 1898, and was succeeded by his chief architect, Walter Hill (d.1909), and by his sons, principally Thomas John Thompson (d.1915) and Walter Stuart Thompson, the firm becoming 'John Thompson & Sons Ltd'. Due to financial difficulties they were forced to take no more new work, the 'goodwill', stocks of materials and equipment were auctioned on 7 September 1938.

The first sequence - previously catalogued - were folders of photographs arranged by subject, and although this was almost certainly artificial, it was still retained. It seemed more logical, however, to arrange the remainder of the photographs - not being in any order - by place, where identified: hence the second sequence. There are c.1000 photographs altogether, c.300 in the first sequence, c.600 in the second, and over 100 still unidentified & uncatalogued.
