## CRANBOURNE RANELAGH SCHOOL, WINKFIELD

[The school was originally a charity school founded by the 1st Earl of Ranelagh in 1709, in a building later known as Cranbourne Hall. In 1877 the trustees placed the school under the control of the School Commissioners, as the Cranbourne Ranelagh School. It moved to a new school building in 1880. The Ranelagh Foundation severed connections in 1908 when it started Ranelagh Grammar School in Bracknell.
