- /13 1926 Feb 15 14 Albany Road, St. Leonards on Sea, [to] Hammond/T.S. Dymond. [Ereky's article on 'Preserving Green Crops' is of 'considerable interest' but the Journal of the Agricultural Education Association cannot accept contributions from non-members. If he (Hammond) were to write 'a short paper on green crop "preserves"' it could be considered (although not if 'pushing a particular patent process') but it would need 'to describe the feeding experiments in somewhat greater detail']
