Administrative/biographical history

The anti-Barrage campaign consisted of a large number of loosely affiliated protest groups and individuals who came together in the late 1980s. The purpose of the campaign was to oppose the construction of a barrage across the mouth of the rivers Ely and Taff. Although the project was regarded by the Government as central to its plans to regenerate Cardiff, to those who opposed the scheme, the barrage was a serious environmental threat to the region and its wildlife. Moreover, there were also serious concerns as to the wellbeing of the long established community who lived in and around the Bute Town area. Prominent in their opposition to the barrage were the Pontcanna Residents Against the Barrage and the Cardiff Residents Against the Barrage groups. The barrage was completed in 2000.
