Administrative/biographical history

Peter Bridger (May 1926-Sep 1994) was lecturer in the philosophy of science at the Welsh College of Advanced Technology (later University College Cardiff) from the 1960s. He was also Chairman of the Cathedral Road Conservation Group, established in April 1972, and member of Cardiff 2000, the civic society for Cardiff.

Archival history

Unknown.

Immediate source of acquisition

The collection was deposited by Dr Douglas A Bassett in February 2008.

Scope and content

The collection consists primarily of correspondence, newspaper cuttings, reports and other papers (1968-1993) relating to Peter Bridger's association with the Cathedral Road Conservation Group and Cardiff 2000, and concerns the history, preservation and development of the built and natural environment in Cardiff and its environs. Also included is a transcript of Mr Bridger's funeral service (1994).
