Administrative/biographical history

Ewart Parkinson (1926-) was appointed as the first City Planning Officer for Cardiff in December 1964. On local government reorganisation in 1974, he became Director of Environment and Planning for South Glamorgan. After retiring in 1985, he turned to consultancy.

Amongst his many positions, he was a founder member and chairman of the Facilities Committee of the Sports Council for Wales (1966-1978), chairman of STAR Community Trust Ltd. (1979-1995), chairman of the Wales Sports Centre for the Disabled Trust (1986-2003), chairman and president of the Norwegian Church Preservation (formerly Rebuilding) Trust (1992-2006), director of the Roald Dahl Arts Project Trust (1995-) and a founder trustee of Cardiff Action for the Single Homeless (1988-). He was also Vice-President for the Wales Council for the Disabled (1982-2000). In 1994, the Millennium Stadium company invited him to lead the design team for the stadium to be the centre piece of the Rugby World Cup in 1999, and in 2000, South Glamorgan County Council invited him to chair an Independent Commission on Councillor's Allowances.

He is a Fellow of the Institution of Civil Engineers and the Royal Town Planning Institute (RTPI); he is also a former President of the RTPI (1975-1976) and was awarded the RTPI Lifetime Achievement Award for his outstanding contribution to planning during his career.
