Administrative/biographical history

AB Electronics was established as AB Metal Products in the 1920s by Sidney Marks, a master toolmaker, in London as a firm of metal stampers and engravers but moved to a factory in Middlesex before 1939, gradually extending its range of domestic electrical and metal goods. Marks moved the business in 1950 to Ynys-boeth Trading Estate, Abercynon, but stayed in London and appointed Henry J. Kroch, a German-born, Swiss-educated engineer. Kroch became managing director in 1964, chairman 1978-1986 and honorary president 1987-1993. AB established itself as a major manufacturer of electrical equipment such as radios and televisions and components for other industries. AB Metal Products became a subsidiary of Gas Purification and Chemical Co Ltd in 1963 but in 1965 was floated as an independent company. AB established an additional factory in 1967 in West Germany and Kroch became a prominent member of trade missions to China, South Africa and other countries. Diversification into micro-electronics and micro-circuits prompted a change of name to AB Electronics Components Ltd in 1967, renamed AB Electronic Products Group 1977. By 1987 the company had eight factories in south Wales but despite a series of commercial ventures, the company struggled against loss of military contracts. The company was taken over by the TT Group in 1992.
