Administrative/Biographical history

The first meeting of Tredegarville English Baptist church took place in 1861 under the Revd Alfred Tilly (1861-1893), former minister (1857-1861) of Bethany Baptist church, Cardiff. The church was required owing to the rapid growth of Cardiff and the number of Baptist adherents. The church was formally opened in the Parade 22 May 1862. Members of the church were instrumental in establishing other Baptist churches in Grangetown, Longcross St, Pearl St, and Splott Rd before 1900 and Llanishen Baptist church 1909. A brief description of the history of the church appears in The History of Nonconformity in Cardiff by J Austin Jenkins and R Edwards James (Cardiff 1901)
