CONTEXT

Administrative/Biographical history: Cardiff Young Men's Christian Association Camera Club was formed in 1896 in Cardiff (Glamorgan). It was amalgamated with the Cardiff Windsor Amateur Photographic Society (founded 1902) in 1910, and became the Cardiff Camera Club. The club had the use of premises in the Y.M.C.A. Buildings in Station Terrace, Cardiff. It was provided with its first permanent clubroom by the Y.M.C.A. in 1936. The club organised annual exhibitions; in 1978, this was held at University College, Cardiff, with the theme "Six Sister Cities of Stuttgart".

CONTENT

Scope and content/abstract: Records of the Cardiff Camera Club, 1906-1990: minute books, 1906-1969; annual exhibition catalogues, 1922-1970; cash book, 1938-1957; and correspondence relating to 'Six Sister Cities of Stuttgart' 1976-1979.
