## Administrative/Biographical history

The church began with a meeting of volunteers requested by the Revd W I Morris of Sardis Welsh Congregational church in 1880 in order to answer the requirements of English speakers. This led to the construction of an English church on Gelliwastad Field in 1881, but the Coedpenmaen area was still in need of provision and the District Congregational Council 1895 encouraged the English church to acquire land on lease from the Bassett estate in Bonvilston Rd in 1896 where a building, later described as the Mission Hall, was functioning mainly as a Sunday School. Services were added in 1898 and a Resident Missioners provided by the Congregational church in 1900. The Bonvilston Rd church formed itself as a separate church in 1920 with the initial support of the Gelliwastad church and appointed its own minister the Revd A C Gravelle in 1922 but the church struggled to survive during the Depression 1926-34. The problem was partly resolved by sharing pastorate with New Road Congregational church, Ynysbwl, from 1942 and benefited from the activity of the Revd D Brinley Richards 1945-47 but the church lacked a minister after his departure until 1969 and had to depend upon lay preachers and 'service' ministers. Falling congregation numbers led to a decision by the church meeting in March 1969 to close the church. Members transferred to the newly-formed Pontypridd United Church.
