CARDIFF, BEULAH, RHIWBINA: ENGLISH CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH

The Congregational cause in Rhiwbina was established in members' homes by the early 19th century. A cottage was rented by the congregation in 1848 and a chapel, built on a leased site nearby, was opened in 1851. The freehold was aquired in 1879 and a new chapel opened in 1891. The former chapel was then converted to an assembly room and school room.
