Administrative/Biographical history: The Edmondes family fortune was founded on careers in estate management, the law and the army. In 1755 the family purchased the estate of Beaupre in St. Hilary which added considerably to their assets in Glamorgan. The Edmondes also occupied Llandough castle from 1776-1794. The family have been called a Welsh example of a early modern nouveau riche family (Thomas, St. Hilary, 2000) who were able to to divide their time between the Town House at Cowbridge and atheir Country Seat at Beaupre.
