The records relate to the work of Donald Maclean, Handcock and Hann, solicitors, Cardiff. Donald Maclean appears in Cardiff directories at 113 Bute Street (1897) and as a partner in Donald Maclean and Handcock at 2 James Street (1908, 1911, 1913, 1915, 1922). Harold Brown Hann of Harrison and Hann had offices at 104 Bute Street (1911, 1913, 1915); he is a partner in Maclean, Handcock and Hann at Baltic House (1922); and later a member of Llewellyn and Hann (1947). The records subsequently passed to Edwards Geldard.
