Administrative/biographical history

Siloh, otherwise known as Seilo Welsh Congregational chapel, was established in 1867 in a barn at Pentre farm as an Independent chapel. It later became part of the union of Independent churches of east Glamorgan (Cyfundeb Annibynnwyr Dwyrain Morgannwg). Its first minister L. Probert was appointed in 1868. The first chapel was constructed in 1869, later becoming part of the vestry. A new chapel was opened in 1878 but emigration from Rhondda in the 1930s and later led to a falling congregation and the old chapel was refurbished in 1985 to serve as the new chapel. The 1878 chapel was demolished and the Baptist Housing Association flats - Llys Siloh were built on the site.
