The church initiated with meetings in a private house of a Mrs Edwards on the east side of Cathays Terrace, Cardiff, in 1858, but the first chapel was erected on the west side of the street in 1862 opposite the junction of Catherine Street with Cathays Terrace. This was later sold and a new chapel opened at the junction of Crwys Road and Fanny Street in 1890 along with a new school chapel in Fanny Street (source: The History of Nonconformity in Cardiff by JA Jenkins and RE James (Cardiff and London 1901))
