Administrative history

Edward John appears to have set up in business on his own account as an agricultural merchant in Cowbridge at some time between 1875 and 1881, having before this been agent in Cowbridge for the seed and manure merchants Hall, Reynolds and Co. By the early years of the twentieth century Edward John's son William H. John seems to have been taken into the business, now named Edward John and Son, and described on its letter-heading as 'Corn, seed, manure merchants and wool staplers'. At some point between 1926 and 1965, the firm became a limited liability company, Edward John and Son Ltd. By 1968, it appears have been part of Rank Hovis McDougall Agicultural Industries Ltd., although still trading under it own name. The business had ceased trading by 1978.

The business was situated in Westgate, Cowbridge, and by the early twentieth century also had branches in Bridgend (Quarella Road) and Llantwit Major. By the 1960s, it included among its customers a large number of farms across Glamorgan, and not only sold agricultural supplies but also bought grain produced on the farms.

Immediate source of acquisition

The records were found in the premises occupied by Edward John and Son Ltd. after the firm had vacated them. They were presented to the Record Office on 13 October 1978 and 4 April 1979 (file number 11/0756).

Content of collection

The records consist mainly of accounting and financial records, including personal (sales) ledgers (1900-1905 and c.1958-1969), purchase ledger (1967-1968), journals (1959-1969), cash books (1956-1959), invoice book (1922-1924), wages books (1958 and 1966-1967), and papers *re* corporate planning (1968-1969). There are also a small number of papers and certificates relating to the cereals deficiency payments scheme (1965-1969), and 3 early twentieth century school exercise books which presumably belonged to members of the John family.

Appraisal, destruction and scheduling information

One volume of invoices for c. 1960s has been destroyed. All other records have been retained.
