Administrative/biographical history

The Workmen's Hall began with the formation by the local Workmen's Institute of a committee in 1910 to arrange for the construction of a new hall in the village to replace an older iron prefabricated building erected in 1891. This building was removed in 1910-11 to a site near the bowling green to provide a home for the Llanbradach Workmen's Social Club (or 'Middle Club'). The new hall opened 10 November 1913, with financial support from Miss Clara Thomas of Llwynmadoc and Pencerrig, and served as a valuable meeting hall and club for a wide cross-section of ordinary, workmen, colliery officials, tradesmen and professional men. The facilities included a library, billiards hall and cinema. The building is now occupied by Llanbradach Working Men's Social Club and Institute Ltd.
