**Administrative/Biographical history:** William Bassett of Miskin (died 1770), sheriff of Glamorgan 1734, was succeeded by his daughter, Cecil Bassett, his son William having died in 1769. Cecil married Stephen White, a Bristol merchant. Their daughter, Ann White of Miskin married Francis Saunderson of Castle Saunderson, cos.Fermanagh and Cavan, Ireland.
