Administrative/Biographical history

John Bruce Knight of Dyffryn, Aberdare (afterwards John Bruce Pryce) inherited the Monknash estate in 1837 under the Will of his distant cousin Mrs. Booth Grey of Dyffryn, St. Nicholas. By the early twentieth century the estate consisted of over 1400 acres in the parishes of Monknash, Marcross and Llandow and also a Western or Neath estate in Cadoxton-juxta-Neath, Michaelston Higher, Pontrhydyfen and Rhos Pontardawe. The family house was at Blaen-y-cwm in the parish.

The papers relate particularly to George Lewis Bruce (1862-1955) who lived at Toynbee Hall, London, then at Woodberrie Knoll, Loughton, Essex, 1904-c.1937 then at Monknash. He was keenly interested in educational matters, and a member of the London School Board 1891-1894 and 1897-1902 and of London County Council 1902-1905. He and his wife were also patrons of the Wick District Nursing Association.

Custodial history

DXNM 4-44 were deposited in the National Library of Wales until transferred to the Glamorgan Record Office in 1967.

Immediate source of acquisition

DXNM 1-44 were deposited in the Record Office by the Bruce family in 1967, and the remainder of the records in 1982.

Content of collection

Title deeds estate accounts and plans; estate papers c.1910-1930s; personal papers; family photographs; London School Board and London County Council papers; Wick District Nursing Association papers; Monknash parish meeting minute book 1918-1972.

Appraisal, destruction and scheduling information

Duplicates and ephemeral material have been destroyed.

For the years 1893 – 1904, the diaries are London School Board diaries, and for 1905 and 1910 – 25 they are London County Council diaries. These contain printed information on the Board and Council respectively, but appear to have been used by G.L. Bruce to record all his appointments and activities, not only those connected with these organisations. For the years 1906 – 1910, and 1926 – 1954, the diaries are small commercially-produced diaries. Entries throughout are very brief and contain a number of abbreviations.
