### *CONTEXT*

**Administrative/Biographical history:** St. Andrews church was built as a chapel of ease to St. John, Cardiff in 1863 and formed into a separate parish in 1884. St. Teilo, Woodville Road was a chapel of ease to St. Andrew, erected in 1895 to replace a temporary building of 1879 in Corbett Road. The Iron church of St. Illtyd stood in Crwys Road. In 1956, St. Andrew's was rededicated as Eglwys Dewi Sant, and St. Teilos became the parish church of St. Andrew and St. Teilo.
