CONTEXT

Administrative/Biographical history: St. Samson is a modern parish, formed in 1924 from the parishes of St. Mary, Cardiff and St. Paul, Grangetown. It was amalgamated with St. Dyfrig's parish in 1967 (to become Cardiff St. Dyfrig and St. Samson), to enable Wood Street to be widened and the bridge rebuilt.
