### *CONTEXT*

**Administrative/Biographical history:** The Church of All Saints, Tyndall Street in the parish of St. Mary was opened to serve the Welsh-Speaking population of the parish. It was formed into a separate district (later parish) in 1867. In 1899 this church was closed and sold in an Act of Parliament and a new All Saints church in Adamsdown Square was consecrated in 1903. This church was closed in 1965 when the parish of All Saints was united with St. John.
