The handbills were removed when the volume was conserved, 1989-90. They were made up into a separate volume.

Only some of receipts give name of brewery. In 1859 Directory John Cox is given as brewer of Little Charlotte Street. O.S. 1:500, 1874 marks Eagle Brewery.
