Records of Fillebrook Literary and Debating Society

Date of donation : 19 February 1988

Formed as Fillebrook Literary Society on 15 November 1904, by members of Fillebrook Baptist Church, Leytonstone. Meetings began in January 1905 at Fillebrook Institute, Fairlop Road. Public lectures were regularly arranged until 1915, latterly with the Congregational and Wesleyan Societies, until wartime conditions forced a suspension of meetings.

These records were formerly in the care of William Colsell, Hon. Secretary of the Society.
