Introduction

Vicarage Road church, Leyton was opened in 1875, with the support of the London Baptist Association on a site given by a resident Baptist pastor. A larger schoolroom was constructed in 1897. A mission hall in Lea Bridge Gardens, in existence by 1885 lasted until 1935. The church was damaged by bombs in World War II.

For further details see the card catalogue for two anniversary brief histories, also the account in 'Churches of Leyton other than Church of England' by Mary Savell (L 81, copy in local collection). Ephemeral material collected at the time of deposit of these records is also catalogued in the card catalogue.

The Sunday School seems to have continued in operation after the last date of these records.
