

Records of Eccles Presbyterian Church of England subsequently Eccles-Pendleton Church of England, 1901-73, n.d., with minutes of Committee of Management, Eccles-Pendleton United Reformed Church, 1972-73.

The following records of Eccles Presbyterian Church of England, Bright Road, Eccles (subsequently Eccles-Pendleton Presbyterian Church), were deposited together with records of Patricroft Congregational Church (N/CC5) and with minutes (U132/AM1) of a Division of the Order of the Sons of Temperance. With the formation of the United Reformed Church in 1972, Eccles-Pendleton Presbyterian Church and Patricroft Congregational Church were united and took the name of Patricroft United Reformed Church. N/PRE1/AM2/6 was continued as the minutes of the Committee of Management of the "Eccles-Pendleton United Reformed Church".
