In 1868 the Adelphi Ragged School was established. In 1888, Walter Southern, one of the School's teachers, arranged to meet his class one evening weekly for recreation, drill, etc., the first of these meetings being held on 3 October. The Club was formally established a few months later, membership being limited to scholars of the Ragged School. Its first title was "The Adelphi Rogged School Lads' Evening Club", later "The Adelphi Regged School and Lads' Club" and, from 1890, the Adelphi Lads' Club. For accounts of its history see U129/Z1.
