The following information on the history of the Eccles and District History Society has been taken from report prepared by Mr. M.W. Devereux, Hon. Secretary of the Society, for its Annual General Meeting in its Silver Jubilee year in 1981. The Inaugural Meeting was held at Eccles Central Library on 1st February, 1956, and was attended by nineteen people; it was resolved that a Society should be formed which should affiliate with the Lancashire and Cheshire Antiquarian Society. The First Annual General Meeting was held on 23rd May, 1956. In 1957 the Society brought out its first publication, Eccles and Swinton: The Past Speaks for Itself, edited by Mr. F.R. Johnston. Among subsequent publications is Mr. Frank Mullineux's The Duke of Bridgewater's Canal. In 1965 the Society began to issue its "Bulletin" which was developed by Mr. Peter Spencer into a semies of printed or duplicated sets of the lectures given each year. The Society also seeks to promote interest in local history by its presentation of the Frank Mullineux Award, named after the local historian, Mr. Frank Mullineux, M.A. Its monthly meetings are held from September to May.

The Society has also published jointly with the City of Salford, e.g. Swinton and Pendlebury: a century of change in words and photographs by Messrs. C. Carson and J.B. Smethurst, 1981, and Eccles: a Collection of Old Photographs by Mr. P. Bowes and Miss M. Patry. It published Eccles: the growth of a Lancashire town by Mr. F.R. Johnston "under the auspices of the Eccles Town Council" in 1967.
