members of deputations, 1884-90 (1 small vol.)

The minutes appearing in the bulk of this vol.
do not have a title (apart from such exceptions as
"Special Committee Meeting") but appear to be of
a committee or subcommittee usually meeting weekly.
It is not clear what is the relationship between
this series of minutes and that catalogued immediately
above. The same names of signatories appear as in
U237/AM1-2 and /CO1/AM1-14.

/AM2-5 Signed minutes of meetings apparently of a committee ?1886,
or subcommittee, 1895-1927 (4 vols., last vol. 1895-1927
containing loose rough notes of a quarterly general
meeting in 1886, probably contemporary; U237/CO2/AM2,
4, slightly damaged by woodworm)
