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

Writ to William Markham, Thomas Pearson & allothers it may concern to implement decree of Charity Commrs. appointed under Act of 43 Eliz. (1601) whereby those in possession of money or lands given for charitably uses are ordered to hand it or them over to Jonathan Yates, vicar of Spratton, & other named feoffees with provision for appointment of new feoffees from time to time, for a nnual a/cs & for paying costs of obtaining the decree.
