
The family of Phillips have been connected with drapery since 1886, in which year Mr. Herbert Clogg Phillips (son of Aaron Phillips) opened a shop in Dychurch Lane, Northampton as a general drapery business. Following this, a further shop was opened in January 1900 in Newland Street, Kettering. Mr. Aaron Phillips died in 1918. At that time a manager was in charge of the Kettering premises and everything was controlled from Northampton. Herbert Phillips's younger brother, Louis, also began a drapery firm in Rushden. The younger of Mr. Herbert Phillips sons, Mr. Edwin Phillips, is father of the brothers (Messrs. Colin and Robin Phillips) who now run the Kettering shop. Rushden continues under the ownership of Mr. Richard Phillips, grandson of Louis and Mr. John Phillips (son of Rosslyn Thomas Phillips, Mr. Herbert Phillips second son) now runs the Northampton shop with his cousin, Douglas, who is elder brother to Colin and Robin Phillips.

Mr. Colin Phillips came over to the Kettering shop in October 1954 and was the first member of the family to work in the Kettering business, although his father had previously taken over this shop. He was joined by his brother, Robin, in May 1955.

In 1955, the Corby shop, which had been a branch of Kettering, closed down and all the shops trading under the name of Phillips are now independent businesses. The Kettering shop, which used to be known as Phillips Warehouse (Kettering) Ltd., has recently changed its name to Phillips of Kettering Ltd. They supply a wide range of household furnishings, including drapery, soft furnishings, floor coverings and carpets. They also used to supply furniture. The firm, which had its foundation 92 years ago, has now become a household name throughout the district.
