

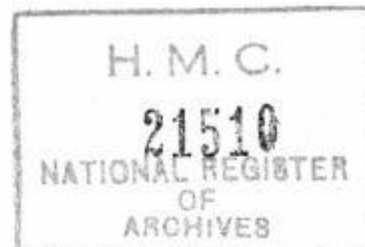

- 9 Ecclesiastical Metalwork Sales Analysis 4th Jan 1957-Dec 1966
Book:
showing columns for job number; total;
rent; carriage; needlework; M.C. and
Ecclesiastical.
- 10 Wages Book: 4th Jan 1963-
31st Dec 1965
shows name of employee, hours worked, rate
paid, overtime, gross wages for week, bonus,
total taxable pay for week, income tax re-
fund, income tax deducted, National Insur-
ance deduction and others, net amount due
and employees contributions.
1963 - 24 on pay roll (includes engineering
works)
1965 - 8 on pay roll
- 11 Bought Ledger: (Cash Book) 1942-1956
firms from whom they have purchased goods;
indexed, shows columns for date, by cheque,
etc., folio, amount and on right-hand side
of page date; to account; folio and amount.
- 12 Cash Books
Cash Book: 1st Jan 1942-
30th April 1946
showing columns for firms name or name of
purpose for which money is debited or
credited (i.e. wages cheque); discount
column; debit and credit.
- 13 Cash Book: 1st May 1953-
31st May 1957
