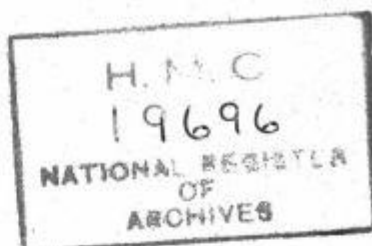

Two deposits have been made of papers and books of the Revd. Charles Henry Hartshorne, Rector of Holdenby 1850 - 65, author inter alia of 'Historical Memorials of Northampton', 1848 and 'Rockingham Castle, its Antiquity and History', 1852, and of his son Albert Hartshorne, a well known antiquary, 1839 - 1910, author inter alia of 'The Recumbent Monumental Effigies in Northamptonshire', 1876.

The collection includes books, pamphlets and drafts of printed articles, 25 albums of sketches, correspondence of the Revd. C.H.Hartshorne and some notebooks and miscellanea.
