CHEPSTOW WATER COMPANY

Formed on 21 March 1836 as The Chepstow Waterworks Company. Incorporated on 11 April 1843 under the name of The Chepstow Water Company. In 1917 it absorbed the Pwllmeyric Water Company and in 1919 the Tidenham Water Works Ltd. The company was superseded in 1960 by the Newport and South Monmouthshire Water Board
