Tintern Abbey Estate

- D902.1 1900 November 3 - 1905 April 27 File of Correspondence  
P. W. Waller, architect and E. Stafford Howard, Office of Woods.  
Tintern Abbey with the surrounding lands to be purchased by the Crown  
from the Duke of Beaufort, 1901. Protective work only is contemplated.  
Notes on repairs in progress to June 1904 and on proposed work to East  
Window.
- D902.2 1898 - 1913 Miscellaneous Bundle  
including photographs (33) of Tintern Abbey, Copy Report by Waller (1901),  
Copy Specifications re East Window (1904) Eastern Arch (1907), Clerestory  
and Arcade (1912), 4 arches east of the Nave Arcade and Clerestory (1913).  
Copy of Guide to Tintern Abbey (post 1905).
- D902.5 1904 - 1913 Plans (73)  
of Tintern Abbey.  
Includes, O.S. sheet XXVI-1 (1902), plans of East window, south wall of nave,  
shoring and centring to 2 bays at west end of nave, proposed reconstruction  
of eastern arch at crossing, shoring to west side of north arch and shoring  
to 4 bays of south nave.
- D902.6 1905 May 3 - 1906 October 22 Correspondence File,  
East Window  
Philip Bayliss, dep. surveyor, P. W. Waller, architect and E. Turner,  
contractor.  
Includes list of works undertaken year June 1904 - 1905 when several parts  
of the foundations of original buildings were discovered. The great East  
Arch in very bad condition and repairs needed. Dispute over part of  
E. Turner's account.
- D902.7 1905 December 29 - 1909 August 27 File of Correspondence  
Eastern Arch of Tower  
Waller and Sons, Philip Bayliss of Office of Woods and Messrs. Demmett and  
Ingle.  
Includes lists of repairs carried out during 1907 - 1919. Estimates for  
resetting Tower Arch (Turner and Son, £635), engineers report with regard to  
use of steel or iron reinforcements full report on work carried out sent to  
Stafford Howard by Waller, 1908 July 9.
- D902.9 1909 May 10 - 1914 April 25 File of Correspondence  
P. W. Waller; Francis Hobbs, Crown Office, Monmouth and John Roberts,  
Crown Keeper.  
Includes Reports on works undertaken from 1909 - March 1913. Repairs made  
to the north transept window and the large west window of nave (1911 Feb.),  
also particulars of the repair work needed to preserve the Abbey from  
further deterioration (1913 August 23) with estimate of costs (approx.  
£6,000).
- D902.3 1901/2 Specification and Plans (24)  
for proposed alterations and additions to St. Anne's House, Tintern.
- D902.4 1902 - 1904 Plans (41)  
of new smithy and cottage.  
Also included, Contract dated 1894 June 1 for erection of a smithy's house  
and forge at Blaisdon, £446.
- D902.8 1907 October Plans and Sketches (27)  
of cottages at Sunnyside, drawn by Waller & Son, architects, Gloucester.
- D902.10 1910 - 1913 File of Correspondence,  
Specification and Plans (3)  
for alterations and extensions to the Beaufort Arms Hotel, Tintern.
