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

The minutes from 1873-1879 have been transcribed from an original minute book and only those described as 'Important resolutions' have been transcribed. The book includes balance sheets 1876-1883, 1885-1886.

ANNUAL REPORT, STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTS AND LIST OF MEMBERS (1893, 1906-1909).

RECEIPT (18 September 1899) of Owen Hughes for the sum of £150, being the sum of money lent to Castle Square Chapel in his mother's name. Endorsed on the original note (27 May 1893).

PROMISSORY NOTE (3 March 1887) from Castle Square church for the sum of £200 lent by David Davies. Endorsed with note that it was cancelled (1900).

LETTER (2 May 1907) J. de Gruchy Gaudin, Bron Siriol, Carnarvon, to the deacons of Castle Square Presbyterian Church, offering to continue to play the organ, despite the fact that he felt that the expenditure on the organ was undalled for, and provided that he was relieved of all responsibility for the mechanism of the organ.

CORRESPONDENCE (1909) re the death of the Rev. Joseph Evans of Denbigh.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (8 May 1880) that Mr. Pugh as a trustee lets the lower room or cellar of Turf Square Chapel for the rent of £5 p.a., Mr. Hamer agrees he will not put anything which might be injurious to the health of those who assemble in the upper rooms or cause a nuisance in the room he was renting.
