He bequeaths all his furniture, goods and household effects to his wife and empowers her to bequeath it to any or either of his grandchildren or to dispose of it during her lifetime. Monetary bequests to his grandchildren Elizabeth and Emma Prytherch and the children of his grandson John Hughes of Maen y drew, pa. Llaneilian. He 'forgives' his daughter Ellen Hughes all her debts to him as representative of her late husband Hugh Hughes.
