ADVERTISING CREATIVE CIRCLE

Records



Deposited on long loan by Terry Grant, Secretary of the Circle, McCann-Erickson, on 22 May 1984.

Unfortunately, due to the frequent removal of these records with the annual change of the secretaryship, the greatest part of the documentation has been lost or destroyed. There is a scanty amount of material from the 1970's, but records become plentiful from 1980 onwards. The early period is represented only by a small scrapbook of press cuttings (ACC 9/1/1).

The Advertising Creative Circle was set up in October 1945 by a group of creative people working in advertising, with the major objectives of raising the general status of advertising by encouraging high standards of creative skill, and of providing opportunities for the interchange of ideas amongst advertising creative people. The first Council consisted of eight elected members, including the President. Ordinary membership of Creative Circle was limited to a maximum of 50 inviduals at the outset (increased to 75 in 1947), besides honorary membership of ten. (See press cuttings in ACC 9/1/1)

By 1980, Council had expanded to contain twelve elected individuals. The objectives of Creative Circle remained essentually the same as at the time of its formation, except for the new inclusion of the aim to promote training opportunities for creative personnel. Full membership (by invitation only) had risen to a maximum of 150. (See paper in ACC 1/6/4) It was in 1980 that Creative Circle took the unprecedented step of introducing a scheme of associate membership (See ACC 1/4/1)

Creative Circle's greatest area of activity is in organising social functions and educational projects. The Circle is particularly renowned for two annual events, the Honours Evening in the Spring (ACC 4) and the Role Reversal Seminar in the Autumn (ACC 5). At this seminar, advertising creative personnel and their clients are invited to exchange roles for a weekend, thus allowing clients the opportunity to prepare material in response to a mock advertising brief.

The records include documentation of the disastrous Honours Evening of 1981 (See ACC 4/2). This was marked by controversy before the event, due to Creative Circle's misguided proposal to give awards for the worst advertisments of the year, alongside those for the best. Fortunately, this plan was later withdrawn. Nevertheless, the bad organisation of the event seems to have caused some damage to the reputation of Creative Circle (indicated by the strong letters of protest in ACC 4/2/7).

Creative Circle's major educational project is the Student Award Scheme (See ACC 6), an annual competition for art students, giving the winners the opportunity to work for a temporary period in the creative department of an advertising agency. The scheme is dependant on financial backing and offers of training places from advertising agencies; it was temporarily abandoned in 1982 due to lack of such support (See ACC 6/6/2).
