From 1863 the church was sited to the East side of the Crosby-Liverpool road (see deeds, 5/1-17 below), but in 1889 it was decided to amalgamate Crosby and Blundellsands churches and a new chapel was built on Mersey Road, Crosby. The church formed part of the Liverpool (Crosby) circuit (formerly Liverpool Waterloo).
