The records are mostly those of (1/below) Liverpool Corporation Waterworks (which came into being following the 1847 <u>Liverpool</u> <u>Corporation Waterworks Acts</u>) and they include many reports on the Vyrnwy Reservoir (which was taken into the care of the Severn and Trent Water Authority in 1974). There is published material only from (2/below) NWWA and North West Water (NWW) whose Western Division took over responsibility for water in Liverpool and west Lancashire on its formation in 1974.
