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**UNION CHURCH, COLWYN BAY**

**Description**

Formerly the English Congregational Church, Abergele Road, Colwyn Bay, founded 1882, closed 2002.

The Congregational cause in Colwyn was founded in 1804 at a cottage called Bryn-y-Gwynt by the Rev Thomas Jones of Moelfre, and services were held here for eleven years. In 1815 a permanent place of worship was built in Colwyn, which continued to be used by the Welsh Congregationalists. After the establishment of the resort of Colwyn Bay in 1866, a site for a Welsh Congregational church in Colwyn Bay was purchased in 1874 and four years later the 'Iron Church' was built where both English and Welsh Congregationalists held services. In 1882 the English section of this church formed a distinct English Congregational Church in Colwyn Bay, with a membership of 11.

The first minister was Rev Thomas Lloyd who served for 40 years from 1884. As the church grew in numbers, it was decided to erect a permanent building and in 1885 the church on Abergele Road was opened, at a cost of £2450. In subsequent years a schoolroom was built. By 1901 the existing church was deemed too small for the congregation, especially during the summer season, and further extensions were added at a cost of £4700, so that the church could seat 650.

Over the succeeding century, membership gradually declined whilst the cost of building repairs and general maintenance continued to rise. The church attempted to address the declining condition of the structure for several decades, but eventually in 2002 decided to sell the building and unite with the membership of another church. The church was bought to be converted into an antique shop by its new owner in 2004.
